PROVENIENCE. The new Block (#6) measures 1 meter x 1 meter, and begins 5 meters from the N.W. end of trench 17.65m long + the wide crossing Str. #3 on a NW-SE fashion. Lot #23 is excavated from the datum point on the northernmost stake down 30cm. This lot contains construction "MOC" which extends from the SW line of Block #6 50cm.
