Fragment of a Candelario which contains two complete chambers and portions of four additional holes. There is no evidence of burning, no fire core, no fine charring. Hardness: 23. The surface is very rough and the holes appear to have been hand made. There are also small, circular holes .3 cm in diameter which do not extend throughout the walls. The complete chambers also bulge outward from the walls of the vessel in a rounded fashion (.3 cm). There is no paint, slip, applique, or incision.
