VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Candeleros fragment. 5 partial chambers visible. Chambers are 3.3 cm deep & are burnt entirely. Burning does not extend to base or exterior wall. There are 2 vent holes near the bottom of two of the chambers. Chambers are 1.3 cm in diameter. One chamber has a 1.9 cm deep clay plug that was pushed down into it after manufacture. This plug of clay is also burnt. Exterior of Candeleros undulates around the chambers so that the wall is not straight. No paint, slip or decoration. Not drawn.
