PROVENIENCE. 40-60cm down from the datum point marked on the southwestern side of Block #12, which measures 1m x 1m and begins 2m from the SE end of a trench 19.65m x 1m, crossing Str. #3 in a NW-SE fashion.

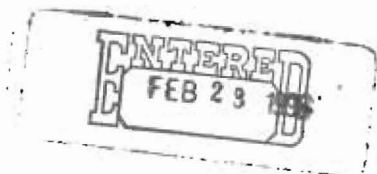

- 1 chert chip, another clipped stone - possibly chert
