PROVENIENCE. 20-60cm down from the datum point marked on the southernmost stake of Block #17, which measures 1m x 1m and begins 7m from the SE end of a trench 19.65m x 1m, crossing Str. #3 in a SE-NW fashion. This Block contains wall/terrace "Abraham Simpson" which is found 40cm down from the datum point, extending the full length of the Block.

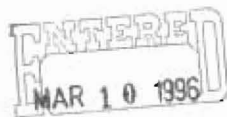
