PROVENIENCE. 40-80 cm down in Block #19 from the datum point on the southernmost stake. The Block measures 1 meter and begins 9.6m from the SE end of a trench 19.65m x 1m, crossing Str. 3 in a NW-SE fashion. Block #19 contains constructions "Groundskeeper W/Flc" which measures 70cm x 1m along the NW line, and "Mr. Burns, which runs perpendicular to "W/Flc" along the NE, and is 50cm wide

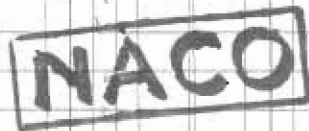
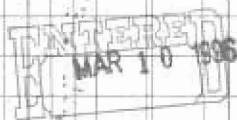
