Full Verbal Description

A donut stone, made from tuff. It is between a rectangle and an oval in overall shape. The biconically-drilled hole is off-center. The hole's maximum dimensions are 5.40 cm on one side and 5.26 cm on the other. The minimum diameter is 3.96 cm. The item was pecked into shape, and some parts of the surface seem very lightly ground. There are no use marks that I can detect, although the hole is slightly off round (unfortunately it is too deep to measure accurately).
