VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Moderately eroded end of a Flute. Interior shows how the tube was made around a stick -- clear end impression. On exterior the round end looks like an animal belly. There are 2 short conical supports (legs): 0.97 high x 1.03 at attachment x 0.40 cm at point; 0.78 x 0.87 x 0.28 at point; height measured on interior, below belly, because of the slanted, very outer-edge, attachment. No slip, paint, burnish. Interior-slitted firing cone. Not drawn; saved for photo. Tube = 1.52 cm across;
