A portion of an ocarina which includes one of the hollowed chambers. There are also two holes which open into it. The remains of what may have been feet protrude from the base of the chamber. Hardness = 2.6. There is a fine ~~core~~ ^{core} which extends to within 1mm of the walls of the fragment. It does not appear to have been binned. The surface is smooth on both sides - only the breaks are rough. There's no paint, slip, decoration, incision or visible applique.
