Figure fragment with incision and modeling. The fragment is flattened and smoothed on one side and rounded on the other. The rounded portions resemble breasts and appear to have been formed by applying a portion of clay and incising a line down the center to form the two rises. The line does not extend beyond the protrusions and they are flattened at the base. There is also a groove which runs parallel to the protrusions and the flattened portion. The surface is fairly smooth, but the tips of the protrusions are much more worn than the remainder of the fragment. There is no silt core or fire cloud. There is also a groove on the flattened side which abuts the juncture of the two pieces, that is 1 cm wide. Hardness 2.5 There is no slip or paint.
