Hollow figurine fragment with incision, applique and possible impressions or abrasions.

There is a fire core which extends to the interior wall of the fragment and stops 1mm before the exterior wall. Hardness = 2.5. The surface is very smooth and there are lines that have been very faintly impressed or brushed onto the vessel on a number of areas. They are thin, parallel marks. There are also abrasions present.

There is a rectangular design - formed by applique and incision - that resembles teeth + gums, but could also be a representation of cells or feathers hanging from a belt. There is a flattened groove which runs parallel to the rectangular design and the back of the figurine curves away from it. The entire rear portion of the fragment curves away from what remains of the front and then flattens as it approaches the base of the rectangular design. There is no slip or paint and the interior of the fragment has a few uneven bumps and lumps. There is also evidence of a hole in the back portion of the fragment - its walls have been flattened and smoothed.
