APPRAISAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a hollow mold-made figurine. There is no fire core, fire clouding, or burning. Hardness: .8. The surface is quite smooth on the exterior, but it is rougher on the interior. There is also a slight circular depression 2.5 cm from the edge of the fragment with the protrusion. The protrusion is 1.3 cm ^{long} and .9 cm wide and .9 cm thick. The front portion is smooth and rounded while the rear is slightly flattened. The portion of the fragment above the protrusion is a rounded bulging eminence. There is no slip, paint, or incision. The protrusion is probably an applique. No handle scars.
