This example includes a large, slightly curved, triangular nose and the remnant of a tooth-filled mouth. There are no lips visible, but the mouth includes the rectangular upper teeth defined by three incisives. The interior surface is fairly smooth. The nose is set off from the teeth by a slight groove.
