Fragment of a figurine. There is no fire core, fire clouding, or burning. The surface is very smooth - especially the broken edges. At one point, it was probably applied on a larger figurine. The surface is so compact that it may have been burnished. The opposite side bears the scar of an attachment to a figurine. Hardness: 1.3. There is no paint, slip applique, or incision.
