Tripod Base

This example of a multi chambered Ocario includes two forward-facing conical legs and a third rear-facing conical leg which combine to form an isosceles triangle. The base includes a spherical sandy chamber and two side-mounted functional stops. The juncture between this chamber and the neck is marked by an attachment scar, and the spherical nature of the chamber is clearly visible.
