The figure below is <sup>the back</sup> part of a whistle. in The figure p. 2 shows how this piece of was worked, we think that the chamber was not bis. The second layer of clay is regularly thin <sup>it's</sup> it not symmetrically balanced. It gives the impression that they were made quickly. In The Fig. 3, show or gives a idea of how bis the chamber was. and the longitud of the backside of the whistle. There is no sign ~~of~~ of any pigment added to this particular piece of fragment. Rectangular mouthpiece, lg. bulb part on the surface, convex distal end. slightly oval opening, further (clay + flint) part but clay cuts are gone, light self slip <sup>from</sup> ~~from~~ <sup>back</sup> ~~from~~ <sup>long</sup> slip

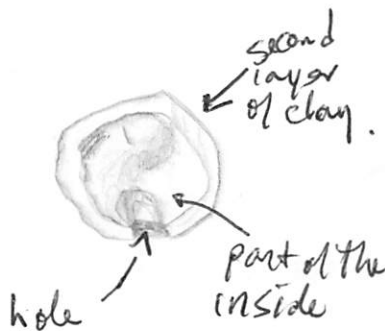
