Fragment of a hollow, reddish-brown figure or ocarina, but design includes a faint figure seated figure, resting hands. Hands have 5 digits defined (thumb is a little shorter than the long finger) + rests on a rounded knee. Waist includes a pectored zone consisted of 3 vertical + 3 horizontal rows, shoulder is very rounded, breast is large + includes a pectored thimble of round rings, with front neck at least one stud of raised, unpecked ovals. Feet sits to back, back is convex, upper neck along feet / back body. No line of feet on slip.
