slightly raised eyes formed by concentric circles, a triangular
head & nose, a big slit mouth beneath the nose &
2 small round ears at the rear of the head. The
arms are broken at there is a perfect seam at the
chest. The base is a tripod support with 3 curved
feet the body is formed by 3-4 splined sandy
chambers with 2 stops in the lower sphere & 1-chamber
the right arm - the back chamber is broken. The head
may or may not be formed by a chamber. The stops
measure 0.8cm, the one visible chamber measures 0.8cm
The work includes a sandy thin red slip. (7.5R 5/4) "wax red"
