Full Verbal Description

Fragment of a hollow multi-chamber ocarina w/ parts of 2. s.s.c. visible. These are connected by a wide channel (1.31cm). Interestingly, the upper chamber is encased by the layer of clay which flows to form the envelope for the lower. Envelope ranges from 0.84cm thick at the juncture of the chambers to 0.09cm thick at the widest points. Interim fig core present on envelope - no fig core in the walls of the chambers proper. No decorative paint, or slip visible.
