VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Small figure of a feline face which opens into a spindly sandy chamber w/ another behind it. The face has a fringed/grooved flange (folks sagittal suture) the brow is also grooved w/ a central cleft, eyes are almond shaped w/ punctated pupils, nose is small w/ punctated nostrils. The mouth is open & showing w/ fangs & teeth, round, indented ear. Smooth convex rear surface, when tilted by wire case part as fig.
