Fragm of a hollow, multi-clubbed ocarina with the lower portion of a tripod figure. Fragment includes the lower 1/2 of the lowest spherical body club + the three conical legs which supported it. The legs are eroded, but measure @ 1 1/2 in. each. There are two flaps part (diam = 0.6) But on the external surface. Inter surface is smooth. No fig. core, paint, or slip.
