Fragment of a hollow anthropomorphic figurine with a head resting on a plain rounded leg. The head includes 5 fingers defined by incision each with a punctated nail, but is slightly raised + differentiated from the ear by a horizontal groove. Inter surface is a mismatch of clay scraps + joins. Inter fig conc no pit or slip.
