Fragment of an elongated v-censer handle which is quite curved. There is no fire core, clodding, or surface burning. The surface is worn and rough and there are brush marks along the entire fragment. These appear to be concentrated along the ~~edges~~<sup>margins</sup> of the handle and are more visible on the exterior surface (with respect to curvature) than on the interior. The marks in the central areas are randomly oriented, crossing back and forth over one another while those near the margins run parallel to the edges. The interior surface is bumpy and there are a few shallow abrasions. Hardness: 7. The margins are steeper than usual the left being flattened and the right with an exterior bevel. There is no paint, slip, applique, or incision. No impression.
