PROVENIENCE, structure 18. Unit 22 is 2 m long (n-s) and 1 m wide (e-w). It is located 4.8 m north of the SE corner of unit 3 and 1 m east of units 6 and 7. This unit should pick up the north-south Namibia feature in unit 21 and the east-west Congo feature in unit 7. Lot 10 is the first room below ground level.
