PROVENIENCE.

Structure 10, unit 23 is 2.1 m long (n-s) by 1 m wide (e-w) and it is above Burundi and Batswana. This unit starts 6.8 m north of unit 83 and ends 8.9 m north of unit 3. It is 1 m east of units 8 and 9. Lot 20 is an excavation area 80cm long (n-s) by 1 m wide (e-w) located 50cm-130cm south of the north sidewall; this space will be leveled to 40cm below datum (the level of unit 9 north of Burundi). (This excavation area is south of Batswana and north of Burundi)

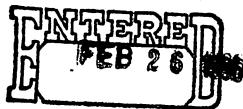
