PROVENIENCE. Structure 18, unit 23 is 2.1 m long (n-s) by 1 m wide (e-w) and it is above Burundi and Batswana. This unit ~~is~~ is 6.8 m - 2.9 m north of the SE corner of unit 3. It is 1 m east of units 8 and 9. Lot 21 was excavated on a 75 cm long (n-s) and 40 cm wide (e-w) located south of Burundi and 40 cm west of the east side wall. This lot will see the extension of Burundi and possibly an explanation for the termination of Namibia.

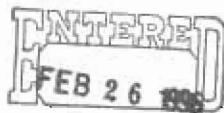
