PROVENIENCE. Structure 18, unit 34 is located 5.6 - 6.6 m north of unit 3 and 3 - 4.6 m east of unit 6. Lot 62 is an excavation area, 50 cm wide (e-w) located 4.1 - 4.6 m east of unit 6. Excavations to 40 cm to reveal the vertical depth of the possible continuations of the Tawanaic feature.

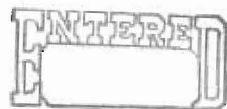
