### Verbal Description

This form is commonly known as a net weight, although in truth I don't think anyone really knows what it is. The overall shape is between an ovoid and an egg. Usually at the midpoint, but slightly off-center on this one, is a groove going around the largest dimension of the piece. The groove has a U-shaped cross-section, and is 0.25 cm deep by 0.35 cm wide at most. The rounded surfaces are smoothed, but the temper protrudes onto the surface. I see no signs of wear or use.
