## Verbal Description

An extremely unprepossessing corner of a metate. Part of its problem is that the holes in this piece of vesicular basalt are very large, leaving even the finished working surface with very large holes. In addition, the piece is not well-made. The <sup>finished</sup> edges are only roughly shaped, as are the sides. These sections have only a little sign of grinding. The bottom of the low leg - I am not even sure how to measure its height, as it is not clearly differentiated from the upper portion. The base of the foot is 3.1 x 3.7 cm, and it is ground down and fairly slick and glossy. The working surface is worn and somewhat glossy on the raised portions.
