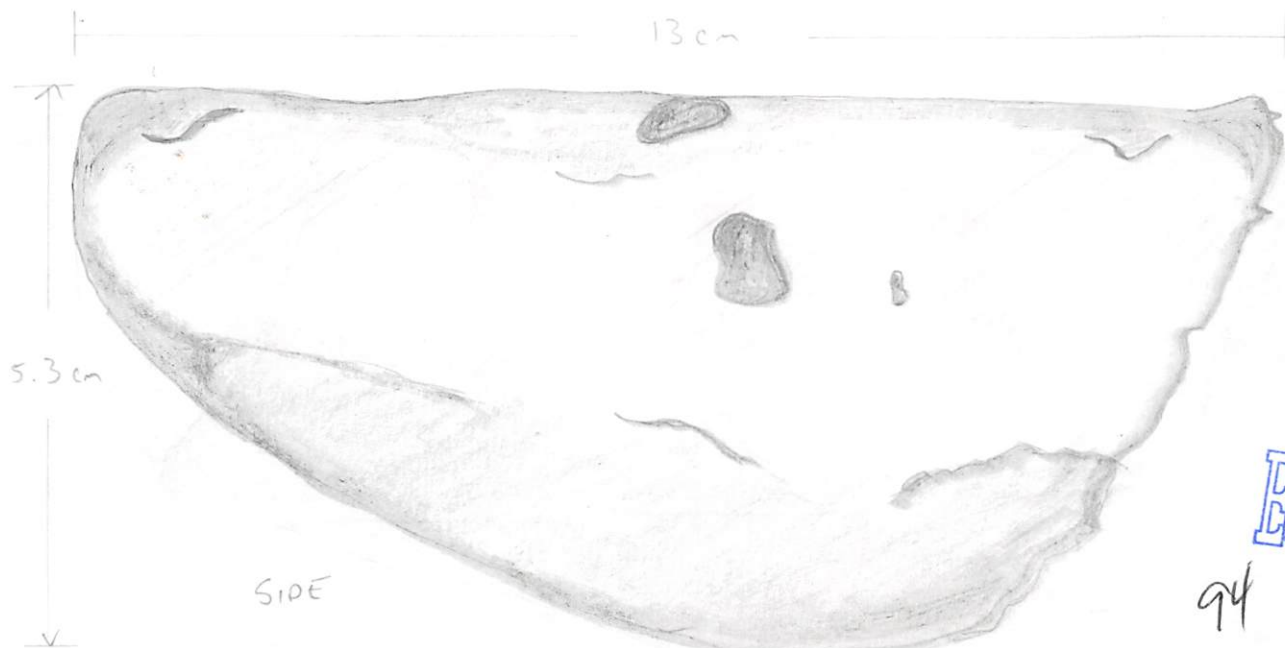

Full Verbal Description

Corner fragment of a groundstone metate. Roughly a triangular-shaped piece, with 2 sides and corner in good condition, with one large break from side to side. Relatively large amount of working surface (top) is here, yet it is worn only semi-smooth. It is much smoother than the worked-curved bottom side, yet still has the bumpy holes, making it a little rough still. Bottom side tapers up to edges, as seen in drawing.
