OPERATION: 728T LOT: 11 DATES: 3/4/96 EXCAVATOR: 75

PROVENIENCE: 0-20 cm down from the northernmost datum point of Block #5, which measures 1m x 1m and begins 4m from the NE end of a trench crossing Str. 3 on a NE-SW meridian. This block contains "Martin Prince" construction, which runs SE-NW and is 40 cm in width, and begins 60 cm from the NE line.

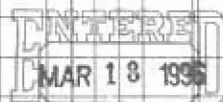
