Fragment of a scored censer body which contains a portion of the rim. The interior is too burnt to detect the presence or absence of a fire core, and the scored side has been charred as well. However, the unscored side escaped unscathed. Hardness = 2.5. The surface of the scored side is quite rough and jagged. The incisions are quite wide (3cm) and appear to have been made with a double-pointed tool - although this pattern is less visible in the vertically oriented striations. The margins of the incisions are quite ragged, and they may have been made on fairly dry clay. On the unscored side there are a number of brush marks which swirl in different directions across the surface. There is no paint, slip, or applique.
