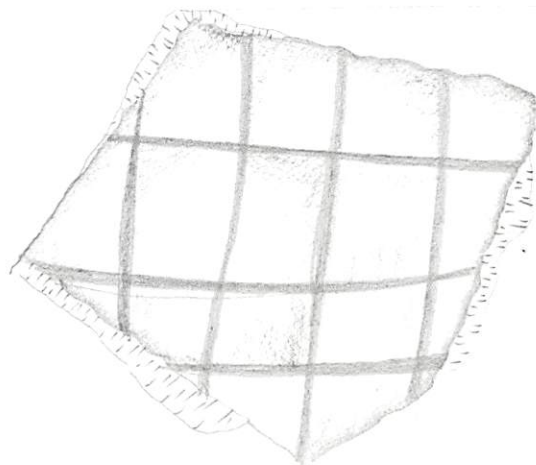

Fragment of a scored censer lid which does not contain any of the rim. There are two distinct fine cores: the principal core is .4 cm in diameter and extends to within .3 cm of the incised surface. The secondary core is .2 cm wide, extends to within .5 mm of the unscored side, and is set off from the primary core by a very thin layer of un-burned paste. The unscored surface of the lid is NOT burnt while the scored surface has been tightly scorched; Hardness = 2.1. The unscored surface has a number of randomly oriented brush-marks and a few depressions and rises, the scored surface is coarser, the incisions are 6.3 mm wide, 1 mm deep, and quite well preserved. The horizontal grooves were definitely made after the vertical and they form a rectangular pattern (as oriented in the drawing). There is no slip, paint, applique, or handle scar.



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
