**Full Description:**

Paste Group (censers + figurines): A Thickness 19.0 cm  
Form (censers): Height 8.4 cm  
Width 10.9 cm  
Diameter

Handle width  
Handle thickness

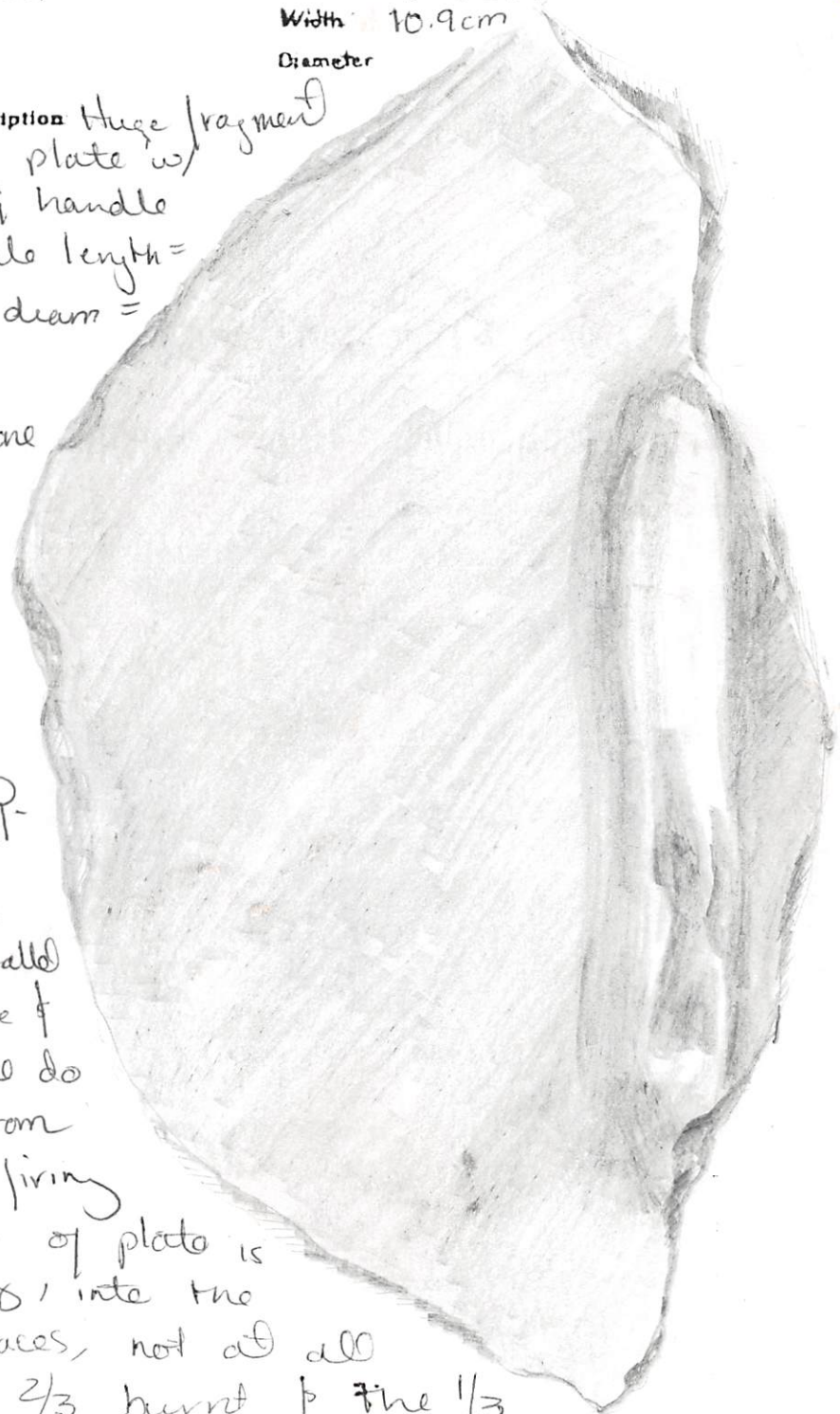


**Full Verbal Description:** Huge fragment

of complex censer plate w/  
part of base & handle  
remaining. Handle length =  
9.8 cm. Base diam =

17.5 cm. Base  
shows part of one  
triangular vent  
hole 1.8 cm long.

Upper side of plate  
is marked w/ very  
heavy, brick sets  
of parallel finishing  
lines going at diff-  
erent angles over  
surface. Handle is  
also marked w/ parallel  
finishing lines. Base &  
underside of plate do  
not show marks from  
finishing. Narrow firing  
core. Upper side of plate is  
burnt unevenly, into the  
paste in some places, not at all  
in others. w/ 2/3 burnt to the 1/3  
from the last 2.0 cm of handle to the edge of the fragment



one unaltered. Underside of plate at broken edge on  $\frac{2}{3}$  of plate that was burnt also shows some greying from fire.

~~Base~~ Ext of base shows heavy burning 1.0 cm down from plate & extending 8.0 from vert on one side & 3.5 cm on other side of vert. Most extensive burning is also on the ~~left~~ fragment of base that corresponds w/ the burnt  $\frac{2}{3}$  of plate. On plate, heaviest burning occurs just before the beginning of the handle. No decoration, paint, or slip.
