VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a molded incensario. The wall is attached to the base by a <sup>molded</sup> basal line of clay (ie ridge) and there is an indentation between the wall & the base at the point of juncture. There is a fire core which is centrally located within the wall & extends to within 2mm of the edges. Hardness = 2.4. Color: paste exterior = 5YR 5/8, 5/8. Paste interior = 5YR 6/8. No apparent fire clouding. The surface shows evidence of smoothing on the exterior, but the interior is markedly rougher, with lumps and blobs of unsmoothed clay protruding slightly from the wall. The bottom is rougher than the exterior, but smoother than the interior, & there is a slight indentation ~~at~~ the point where the wall & the base abut. (1.34 cm from the edge of the basal ridge). No apparent slip, decoration, <sup>applique</sup>, or incision (barring the basal ridge).
