VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Solid, mold-made, anthropomorphic body fragment. This solid, incised, unglazed-like headless flange was probably attached to a hollow figurine. The edge is severely squared, the back is flat to within 1.5 cm of the broken margin where it begins to curve outward. No paint, slip, or applique. Beneath the flange there is a small protuberance which is part of the face.
