Fragment of a Candelero which contains two partial grooves. The inclusions are quite large and very noticeable. A portion of the base is also present. The exterior is rough and there are a few abrasions. The flutes' interiors are slightly smoother. There is a fine core, but it does not extend uniformly throughout the fragment. The interior flute walls are black, but the exterior walls are not. There is no surface burning or fine clouding. No paint, slip, applique, or incision.
