Portion of a pierced ladle censer. There is a fire core .4 cm wide which extends to within 1.2 mm of the interior surface and less than 1 mm of the exterior surface. The exterior surface shows evidence of either firecladding or post-firing burning while the interior does not. Hardness: 2/2. The surface is fairly smooth. There is an interesting honey-comb effect on the interior surface, as if the clay had been extremely wet when the vessel was formed. The paste also appears to be lighter near the margins of the holes. The portion of the fragment closest to the hole is rather concave. There is no paint or slip. No applique or modeling.
