Fragment of an elongated U censer handle with mat impressions. There is evidence of a small amount of burning on the side without the mat impressions. There is a slight fire core 3cm wide which extends to within 3cm of either wall, there is no fire clouding. The mat impressions are quite pronounced, run vertically along the length of the handle, form a quadrilateral pattern, and extend to within 5cm of either side of the handle. The side without the impressions has a few grooves and is slightly uneven in thickness. There is no paint, slip, applique, or incision.
