VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a scored censer lid. The scored side has been burned while the exterior (opposite) side escaped unscathed. There is a fire core, 1.3 cm in diameter, and extending to within 1.2 cm of the lid walls. Hardness 2. Color: paste exterior = 10YR 7/3 paste interior = 10YR 8/8. The unburned, unscathed side is fairly smooth, but not of uniform thickness: there are a few uneven depressions. The scored, burned side is markedly rougher. The incisions are fairly deep - 1.5 mm - and the horizontal grooves (as oriented in the drawing) were made after the vertical. There is no applique or molding.
