VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a ^{hollow} censer frag. There is a fire core within the frag itself which is .3cm thick & extends from the interior surface to within .3cm of the exterior. The portion of the base which is present contains a fire cloud 2x4cm and 1x3cm. The interior portion of the bowl shows some evidence of burning as well. The surface is rough and there are parallel abrasions running along the vertical length of the frag. There are abrasions which run in a circular fashion about the base of the frag where it joins the base of the censer. The frag appears to have been secured to the base with the aid of extra clay. There is a small hole .7cm in diameter and slightly ~~long~~ ^{flat} in shape 1.5cm x 2.5cm from the edges of the frag. The rim of the bowl is fairly flat. There are a few large inclusions. There is no slip, paint, applique or incision.
