Hollow censer prong which includes a small portion of the base of the censer bowl. The prong is complete and almost perfectly circular along its entire length. The tip is smooth and rounded and the base also rounds out smoothly into the bowl. The prong is everted from the bowl and there is a hole .8 cm in diameter in the center of the prong's exterior facing. There is surface burning along the entire prong, including the bases exterior, the interior is burnt. There are parallel abrasions which run the length of the prong on all parts of the rounded portion. The base has a few deeper abrasions. The margin of the hole is ragged and protrudes upward from the remainder of the surface. There is no paint, slip, applique or incision.
