Fragment of a hollow figurine. There is no fire cones, fire clouding, or surface burning. Hardness 2-7. Both surfaces are quite smooth and the clay appears to have been quite wet when it was worked. There are a few abrasions on the exterior, but these appear to have been post-depositional. The fragment is rounded and smooth on the upper portions and is flattened on the bottom. It may have been a portion of the foot of a <sup>rounded</sup> figurine. There is no paint, slip, applique or incision.
