Fragment of a hollow figurine. There is no fire core, fire clouding, or burning. Hardness 2.4. The decorated surface is much smoother than the undecorated surface, and it may have been burnished. The design consists of small punctations arranged in roughly straight lines, across the entire surface of the fragment. They are regularly circular in form and quite shallow. There is no paint, slip, applique, or modeling.
