Fragment of a hollow, mold-made figurine. There is a fire core which extends from the interior wall to within 2cm of the exterior surface. There is no fire cladding or surface burning. The exterior surface was, at one time, very smooth, but portions of the smooth layer have flaked off, leaving a rough surface. The interior surface is quite rough and there is a circular depression which corresponds to a rounded raised feature on the exterior. This rounded exterior feature is topped by a small incised hole. Above the rounded eminence there is a rounded, rectangular applique which is bifurcated by an incised groove. It is also outlined by incision. There is no paint or slip.
