VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Allen, mold made, anthropomorphic fig frag with a portion of a flanged headless. Flange is incised feathers, possibly, - and is in the wing motif. There is one narrow, vertical flange with narrowly spaced ^{horizontal} incisions, bordering a wider square with widely spaced incision both are demarcated by a curving, wing-shaped flourish which is lightly scored. The back of the head is very slightly convex, while the back of the solid side flanges are flatter. All rear exten surfaces are smooth. Intern surface is rough, NO fing core, cladding, surface lining, part or slip. the side of the exten flange is very squared off
