VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

~~At~~ Solid mold-made, frag of a hollow anthropomorphic figurine. Part of a flanged headdress. The face is a grumpy feline with a curved ear - or scoll - a pitted ellipse eye with a finely punctated pupil, thick, snarling lips, sharp teeth & a pointed nose. The top of the face is squared & flattened, the back is flat & smooth until it fans outward to form the convex back of the head. There are traces of a bearded fringe below the zygomatic (2 incisives) and the headdress appears to have continued above the zygomatic. No firing core, cladding, lining, applique, paint or slip. Very unusual fragment.
