VERBAL DESCRIPTION:

Fragment of a mold made figurine with part of the face with a very large, puffy brow and a one-tiered headdress with vertical incisions which seem to define feathers. The eye is a pulled ellipse with a punctated puffy pupil & iris (the pupil is very small). There is also part of the mouth ~~or possibly~~. There is a scar where ^{handle} a flange may have been attached. Back is flattened behind the headdress and curved where the flange may have attached. Traces of orange ~~pink~~ on the back and blue prints in the mouth.
