Tripod Base

This is a studied tripod base, broken half-way through both of the functional stops. The rear leg of the tripod sits lower and further from the other two supports so that (with the rear point at the apex) the legs form an isosceles rather than an equilateral triangle. The base is formed by a spherical sanding chamber.
