### Anthropomorphic Facial Fragments

This example includes a slightly curved triangular nose, almond-shaped eyes and a raised lipped mouth with a marked indentation of the upper lip. The mouth also includes a wedge-shaped, T-shaped tooth with a central vertical incisor. The chin is separated from the neck by a fairly deep groove. Internally by Core.
